

Damp Proofing Problem? Don't let it get any worse.

Danford Brewer & Ives are damp proofing experts in Yorkshire, Teesside & Cheshire. We assess Dampness, Timber Problems, Wall Stabilisation and Basement Conversion works with a survey carried out by our own qualified surveyors. There are several different types of damp, and we assess which type it is before treating it accordingly.

Rising Damp

Rising damp is not the most common form of dampness encountered in buildings; this is left to condensation, however, it is very likely that a high proportion of older buildings are affected by rising damp to some degree or another, and it does cause problems. With positive identification, appropriate remedial action and ancillary works can be carried out.

Rising damp in buildings may be defined as the vertical flow of water up through a permeable wall structure, the water being derived from ground water. The water rises through the pores (capillaries) in the masonry by a process loosely termed 'capillarity'. In other words, the masonry acts like a wick.

Obvious signs of rising damp are patches of damp on external walls or moss growth, and interior walls may look or feel wet, or bands of salt may appear.

Penetrating Damp

Penetrating damp can happen when parts of the building such as inadequate or faulty roofing, windows, brickwork etc. allow water to penetrate the walls of a building.

If any of the outsides of the building is unsound, such as cracked render or brickwork, blocked or broken guttering, poorly fitted door or window frames, or uncapped chimneys etc. rain can easily penetrate into the building, causing damp. Some common signs to look out for are tide marks on internal walls or discolouration of interior decoration, salt deposits, blistered plaster, damp skirting boards or black mould on internal walls or window frames.

Stop the Rot.

Both dry rot and wet rot are caused by moisture, commonly from poor ventilation below the floor, rising or penetrating damp, water leaks etc. Normally, dry rot happens from relatively low moisture levels, and wet rot is from very high moisture levels.

Wet Rot

Wet rot can be a white or brown rot, which does not refer to the colour of the mould, but the shade that the timber turns when affected. Brown rot will darken the wood, and will break in small cracks, where as white rot lightens the wood and the damage is visible across the grain.

Treating Wet Rot

Once Danford Brewer & Ives have identified the problem to be wet rot, the area will have to be properly ventilated to allow the wood to dry and the root cause of the problem will have to be solved. Any damaged timber may have to be replaced and specialist treatments carried out.

Dry Rot

Dry rot is different from wet rot in the sense that it can travel through a building taking its own moisture supply, and can travel between plaster and brick work as well as wood. Dry rot can cause severe damage if it is not treated.

Treating Dry Rot

Treating dry rot can be quite disruptive, as locating the causing source may require floor boards to be taken up or walls to be opened up. All affected timbers will need to be removed and the damp areas will have to be dried out thoroughly, and specialised fungicide treatments will be applied.

Woodworm

There are many different types of woodworm and they all cause damage to any timber they choose to live in. Woodworm larvae bore holes in the wood in search of food; cellulose.

Treating Woodworm

Danford Brewer & Ives will first determine the species of woodworm causing the damage as different circumstances need different treatments. Depending on what they find, Danford Brewer & Ives can treat the woodworm with either a chemical spray, injection or surface paste.

Various Work Included in Converting Your Cellar:

- Excavation & Underpinning
- Waterproof Membranes

You may think it's not possible to make an extra room out of your cellar because of it's low ceiling, or perhaps you don't currently have a cellar at all. Danford Brewer & Ives can create a new, liveable space for you by lowering the foundation of your house through a method called underpinning.



Underpinning can extend existing foundations of a building by depth or width to either give a cellar more headroom where the current cellar is too shallow, or to create a cellar where there currently is none.

Danford Brewer & Ives will excavate soil from beneath the existing foundations, and fill most of this excavation with concrete. Once the concrete has settled, the remaining gap is filled with a sand and cement mix. This is carried out step by step to ensure the foundations are solid at all times.

A structural engineer will draw up the underpin schedule, and alongside building inspectors, will inspect the work as it progresses then approve it once the underpinning is complete.
